Do you know that there are different types of specific learning disorders?

A specific learning disorder occurs when an individual has difficulty learning often due to **insufficient development in an academic area** (such as reading, writing, or math) or they are **lagging skills in the areas of language and communication**.

An intellectual disability is different from a learning disability. Unlike intellectual deficits, individuals with learning disabilities have a **specific neurological impairment**.

A specific learning disorder may be caused by **heredity**. Learning disorders often run in the family—children with learning disorders are likely to have parents or other relatives with similar difficulties. For example, dyslexia is often hereditary.
