### What are UDL-aligned strategies?

UDL-aligned strategies are the instructional methods and tools teachers use to ensure all students have an equal learning opportunity.

### Why do we use UDL-aligned strategies?

It provides different strategies/tools for the following areas:

- engagement
- representation
- expression
